# Business items:

## I. Minutes and Financials

- 1. Approval of Minutes for September. Bill motioned and Julia Seconded. Approved unanimously.
- 2. September Financials were approved: No concerns noted. Laurie Motioned Bill Seconded. Unanimously approved.
- 3. Annual Analysis Dave advised the Council.
  - Registered households continue to gradually decline year over year. This downward trend is slightly offset by increased tithing households and average weekly collections in the current year.
  - 2. Tithing households and average weekly collections are down noticeably compared to 2020.
  - 3. The impact of these trends has gradually decreased the unrestricted cash as our tithing is not keeping pace with operating expenses.
  - 4. The combined impact of these factors has decreased our general fund by 12% since 6/30/2020 and down by over 14% from last year, which is almost \$30K or the equivalent of one-month average operating expenses.
  - 5. The Ignite campaign has taken away from regular tithing.

#### **New Business**

- 1. Building and Grounds: John Roberts.
  - a. Bell Tower repair at St Mary's is going to be done soon and some drain repairs. Around \$6000.00 estimated. This was approved at previous meetings. Need to review budget to see if it is allocated. Done before winter.
  - b. Parking lot repaving at St Mary's: \$121,000.00 and \$79,000.00
  - c. Parking lot lights estimate is \$32,000.00
  - d. Holy Cross Roof leaking in Nw corner of Sanctuary.

- e. Holy Cross Interior Paint and Cracking. Scott will be reviewing.
- f. Trees at the rectory needing attention for trimming or removed working with professionals to get worked.
- 2. New Member to Finance Council: Craig Johnson
- 3. Father will be giving an update to the parish in the fall.
